

# NORTHWOODS BAPTIST CAMP GUIDELINES

We believe these rules reflect the commitment and purpose of this Christian camp. Campers not complying with these regulations may be asked to leave the camp.

## 1. ALCOHOL, DRUGS, AND SMOKING

No alcoholic beverages, tobacco, or other controlled substances will be allowed on this property.

All prescription medicines must be monitored by the camp nurse.

## 2. ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOR

This camp will not tolerate individuals indulging in anti-social behavior considered detrimental to the total group welfare.

## 3. DAMAGE, BREAKAGE, AND VANDALISM

Any damage to or defacing of camp property is a major violation of camp policy and preventing it should be an important part of the director's effort to have a good camp week. Any such damage will be repaired or replaced as needed and paid for by those responsible for the damage.

## 4. WATERFRONT RULES

No swimming or water activities without proper supervision which means: a trained lifeguard with CPR training shall be on duty for the first twenty people; after that, additional observers shall assist the lifeguard. Only experienced swimmers may swim beyond the roped-off area. Boats and canoes must not enter the swimming area. Everyone will wear a life-jacket while canoeing or boating. There will be no mixed swimming of boys and girls.

5. No fireworks, water balloons, or shaving cream fights. (see rule 3)

6. No physical contact between male and female campers.

7. No electronic devices that play media of any kind.

No TVs, radios, magazines, video games, tape players, CD players, MP3's, iPods, PC's or laptops will be allowed at any time.

8. No cell phones.

Cell phones will be turned in to counselor and returned upon leaving on Friday.

9. In the event of an emergency

All activities are to be stopped and campers report to the chapel hall.

# GENTLEMEN'S CODE OF CONDUCT

It is not too much for us to ask that you dress like a Christian. These are not suggestions these will be strictly enforced.

- Dress clothes are requested for the evening service which includes a collared shirt.
- Pants are to be worn on the waist. (Belt preferred)
- No sweat pants. Cut-offs or shorts allowed FOR SWIMMING ONLY
- No shirts with questionable pictures or emblems or words.
- No see-through or mesh-like material shirts.
- No sleeveless shirts.
- No mod or faddish style clothing.
- No earrings or necklaces.
- Hair must be off the ears and collar. No rat tails.
- Shoes must maintain nice appearance.

# LADIES' CODE OF CONDUCT

It is not too much for us to ask that you dress like a Christian. These are not suggestions these will be strictly enforced.

- Dress clothes are requested for evening services: dresses or skirts.
- Modest clothing is loose fitting clothing that covers all skin from the knee to the shoulders.
- No sun dresses with narrow straps or low necklines or low backs.
- Modest loose fitting tops, blouses, skirts and skirt-type culottes.
- Culottes must have a pleet. No baggy shorts that you call cuolotts.
- No shorts, miniskirts, or pants of any kind.
- Skirts, dresses, and culottes must touch the floor when kneeling.
- No slits above the knee.
- Modest one-piece bathing suits.
- No sleeveless tops.
- No mod or faddish style clothing.

Any violation of the above rules will be dealt with according to the discretion of the camp director and staff. We reserve the right to ask any camper to change an outfit if, in the estimation of the staff, it is immodest or inappropriate.
